You deserve financial relief

Family Reach partners with the Multiple Myeloma Research Foundation (MMRF) to provide financial assistance to **people with multiple myeloma who are currently on a clinical trial.**

- **Covering your everyday needs:** We help with non-medical expenses like rent or mortgage, groceries, phone payments, electric bills, transportation to treatment, and more. Some assistance can be sent to you by check, while the rest is paid directly to the billing vendors.
- **How to apply for support:** Your healthcare provider (such as a social worker or patient navigator) can confirm your income eligibility and apply for assistance on your behalf at familyreach.org/financialassistance.
- **Additional 24/7 support:** Go to familyreach.org/gethelp to search for resources by zip code and view financial guides in Family Reach's Financial Resource Center.
